Economy: Wood, fishing, and whaling.

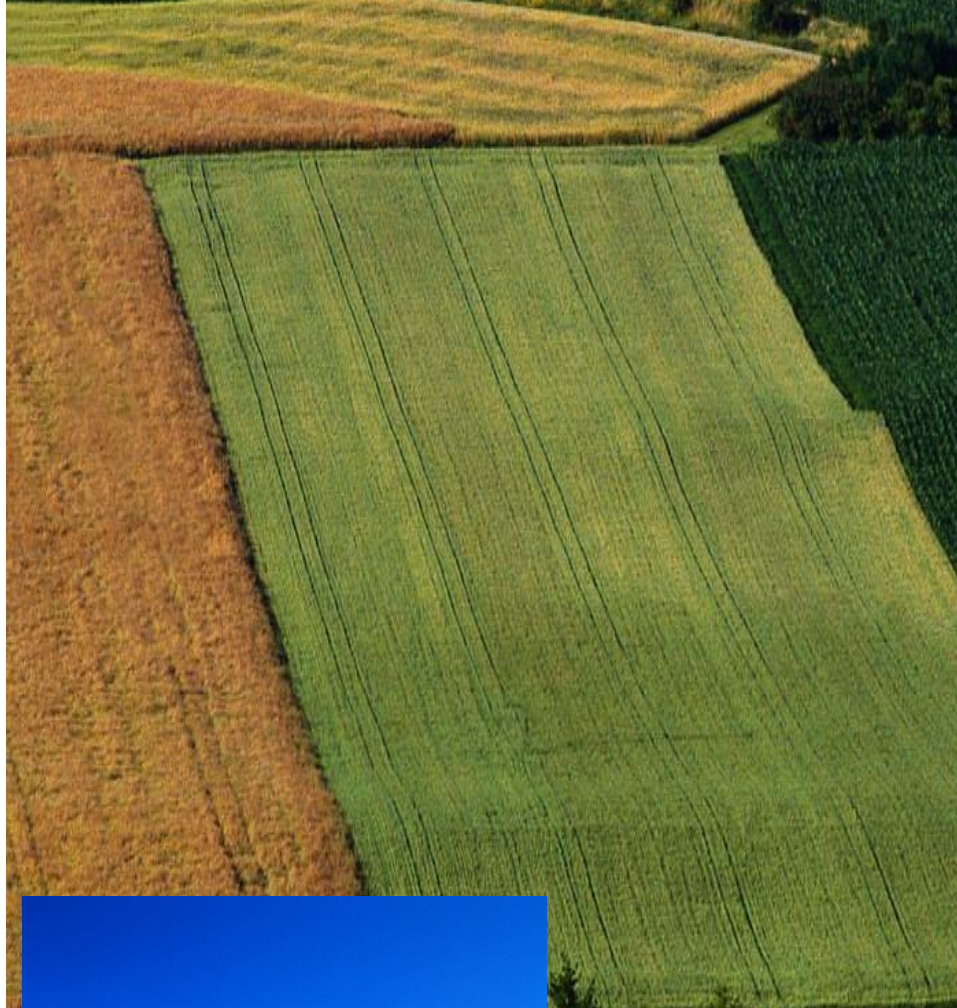


Middle Colonies

Geography: good soil quality, long growing seasons, lots of rain, large wide rivers.

Economy: crops and hunting .

Southern Colonies

Colonies: Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia.

Geography: Excellent soil, long growing seasons and lots of rain.

Economy: Corps and waterway transportation.
